

Kischi Sipi Namao Committee Scholarship Details



About KSNC:

The "Kischi Sipi Namao Committee"(KSNC) was established in 2013 and is a partnership committed to protecting and enhancing Lake Sturgeon populations in the Lower Nelson River.

Scholarship Value:

At least one award of \$2000 for each of the five Kischi Sipi Namao Committee First Nations (Fox Lake Cree Nation, Shamattawa First Nation, Tataskweyak Cree Nation, War Lake First Nation, York Factory First Nation), could be awarded on the basis of deserving applications. Award will be granted in two equal payments – an initial installment of \$1000 given upon receipt of proof of enrollment, and a second installment given upon receipt of proof of enrollment in a second term.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Must be a registered member within one of the following First Nations: Fox Lake Cree Nation, Shamattawa First Nation, Tataskweyak Cree Nation, War Lake First Nation or York Factory First Nation.
- Must have applied to a post secondary institution prior to scholarship application, and provide evidence of enrollment prior to receipt of award.

Application Checklist:

Ensure you have included all items in order for your application to be reviewed.

- Application form (next page)
- 250 word written submission
- Transcript or evidence of GED equivalent
- Letter of reference from either a teacher or principal in your school or an employer if you have completed high school more than 2 years ago.

Award Process:

- Successful applicants will receive the first installment payment upon receipt of proof of enrollment by the KSNC.
- All applicants must meet the eligibility criteria listed above. Applications will be evaluated based primarily on content included in the written submission.
- Deferrals are evaluated on a case by case basis.
